Dear Mr. Grady:

As special counsel for the City of Abbotsford, we have been asked to review certain documents related to an amendment to the City's Tax Incremental District ("TID") No. 6 Project Plan and to provide an opinion as to compliance with the requirements of Wisconsin Statutes 66.1105(4) as they relate to such an amendment. In accordance with that request, we have reviewed copies of the following documents (collectively, the "TID Amendment Documents):

- 4. The TID Amendment Boundary Map;
- 5. Resolution of the Abbotsford Plan Commission dated July 31, 2018 approving and adopting the TID Amendment and recommending the TID Amendment to the Abbotsford City Council;
- 6. Resolution of the Abbotsford Common Council dated August 13, 2018 approving and adopting the TID Amendment; and
- 7. Resolution of the Joint Review Board called by the City of Abbotsford dated August 27, 2018 approving the TID Amendment and the resolution of the Abbotsford City Council dated August 13, 2018 approving and adopting the TID Amendment (item 6, above).

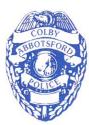

Minutes from the November 7, 2018 Abbotsford City Council Meeting held in the Abbotsford City Hall Council Chambers.

Administrator Grady called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Roll Call: Mayor Voss, Anders, Horacek, Totzke*, Clement, Huther, Faber, and Weideman

Others present: Administrator Grady, Deputy Clerk Luedtke*, Kevin O'Brien (Tribune Phonograph), Lucas Dorn (Johnson & Block)*, and Sean Lenz (Ehlers)*

Comments by the Mayor: No comments

Public Comments Pertaining to the Agenda: No Comments

Minutes – Motion *by Anders/Horacek* to approve minutes of November 5, 2018 *Motion carried unanimously*.

Presentation of 2017 Audit by Lucas Dorn of Johnson Block

Mr. Dorn gave his presentation based upon a handout given to all City Council members. The complete report and presentation are available on the city website.

The financial statements issued as of 11-7-18 and are accurate based upon the information provided to Johnson Block by the city. The auditors found that there were no repeating problem as previously reported such as lack of invoices and deleted transactions.

The general fund balance stood at 52% which equates to 6 months operating cash. The general recommendation is 3-6 months. The 2017 ending balance was \$799,959 continuing a downward trend since 2012.

The trend in shared revenue from the state of WI is fairly flat with the city receiving between \$451,000-\$475,000 over the last 5 years. Property tax levies excluding tax increments increased in 2017, however, the city fully complied with state imposed levy limits.

Out of the total property tax levy, the city portion was 27% plus another 10% for the TIF district. City expenditures broke down to 29% for public safety, 19% for public works, 17% for debt service, 12% for general government, 8% Culture & Recreation, 8% Capital Outlay, and 7% Conservation & Development.

The trend in the city's equalized value is going up. Over the previous six years the equalized value increased 16.7% even with an \$8.8 million dollar drop in 2015 due to a correction in commercial value.

The water and sewer utility's both saw increases in their net position. It was noted, that the city should look at the rates to see if they are going to satisfy future obligations of both utilities.

The city's general obligation debt limit was \$6,499,365 in 2017. At the end of 2017 the city had 52% of it's debt capacity remaining.

TID 6 had a negative balance in 2017. This is due to expenses incurred for the TID in 2017 while the revenue for the period was not received until 2018 (\$260,000).

Mayor Voss asked if the changes made by the city have made the auditor's job easier. Mr. Dorn responded that they have. Mayor Voss asked if there were any deleted transaction in 2017. Mr. Dorn responded no.

Mayor Voss asked if the auditor used strictly Workhorse to create the financial documents or excel spreadsheets provided by the city. Mr. Dorn responded that they had to use both. They like to confirm balance sheet items in the software and test the income statement items.

Mayor Voss asked if there was an audit trail in Workhorse. Mr. Dorn said that there was none. While he has never seen a deleted transaction in other municipalities the fact that one can do it alarming.

Ald. Anders if the data deleted from populated accounts is gone forever. Mr. Dorn responded that there is no way to recover the data. Ald. Anders asked about \$400,000 that appeared on previous year's statements that had disappeared. Mr. Dorn said that he was told that the transaction was not actually posted and there was no way to recover the data.

Ald. Clement asked if 2017 was the last year for a grant that the wastewater treatment plant received. Mr. Dorn stated that it was, however, the operations expenses associated with it should be as high in 2018.

Ald. Anders asked whether the \$95,000 repayment from the water utility for a "loan" should be included in revenues. Mr. Dorn replied that it should, but there is no actual cash involved. It is a paper transaction. Ald. Anders reminded the council that eventually the revenues are not going to be in the budget.

At 6:04 Ald. Totzke entered the meeting.

Ald. Faber asked about depreciation. Mr. Dorn replied that depreciation is expensing the cost of an item over its usable life.

Presentation of TIF Bonding Update and Options by Sean Lenz of Ehlers

Mr. Lenz presented the City Council with the status of the city's TIF bonding efforts and possible solutions. The initial offering for revenue bonds was presented to local lenders who declined to make an offer. Local lenders did express a strong interest in general obligation bonds.

Mr. Lenz expanded the pool of lenders and stated that there are still ongoing negotiations with the bank placement agent – D.A. Davidson. One lender is consider the bond proposal and there is a 75% chance of approval from the lenders credit committee. The estimate interest rate is 4.50% to 4.75%,

The feedback and concerns that Mr. Lenz was hearing from banks is the current concentration of the TIF increment valuation in one taxpayer. In addition, the lack of a Development Agreement is also a concern. Mr. Lenz noted that this is also a positive for the city due to the availability of increment for other projects.

Mr. Lenz presented a sample amortization table for a \$2.35 million bond at 4.75% showing that the approximate yearly payment would be about \$310,000.00/year. The increment is currently projected to be \$383,483 in 2019, \$441,034 in 2020, and \$498,585 in the remaining years of the TIF. These increments assume that there is no other development in the district.

The back-up options are a State Trust Fund Loan, a general obligation bond, and a bond/anticipation note. All option have negative aspects to them.

The State Trust Fund Loan will carry a higher interest rate. The current estimate is at least 5.50%. In addition, it is secured by state shared revenue. If the city were to default then the State Trust Fund would use shared revenue until the loan is paid.

A general obligation bond would have a lower interest rate – less than 4%. However, it would reduce the city's remaining borrow capacity to \$1.425 million. This would limit the city's ability to borrow in the future in case of an emergency. State law limits general obligation bonding to 5% of the city's equalized value.

A bond/note anticipation note is a 5 year note with a balloon payment at the end. There is a commitment by the city to issue a general obligation bond at the end of term to pay off the note. The city would have the ability to pre-pay the note with TIF revenue, however, any unpaid portion would have to be paid off with a general obligation bond lowering the city's bonding capacity.

Committees

Public Works/Water/Waste Water (Faber)

Chair Faber stated that these were the invoices that were described to the City Council by Todd Trader of MSA at the November 5, 2018 meeting. Administrator Grady stated the city had just received a CDBG reimbursement check in the amount of \$317,976.23 for CBDG expenses already incurred by the city. It is the intent of the City Administrator to pay items A & B with monies from CDBG reimbursement and that the remaining monies will be transferred to the City Treasury to reimburse the city. Following CDBG reimbursements will also be transferred to the City treasury to reimburse the city.

Motion by *Weideman/Huther* to approve Pay Application #2 for Haas Construction Cedar/2nd Project (CDBG) in the amount of \$3,000.00 - *unanimous*

Motion by *Anders/Horacek* to approve Pay Application #3 for Haas Construction Cedar/2nd Project (CDBG) in the amount of \$160,178.36 – *unanimous*

Administrator Grady stated that pay item C was a TID expenses and that when the city received its TID bonding the city treasury would be reimbursed.

Motion by *Weideman/Horachek* to approve Haas Construction Subdivision – Pay Application #2 in the amount of \$373,111.07 and that the city treasury will be reimbursed when TID bonding is received. – *unanimous*

Motion by *Anders/Huther* to table approving new water pumps until more information about the quote can be provided. - <u>unanimous</u>

Colby/Abbotsford Police Commission Meeting

October 8, 2018

6:30 P.M.

The Colby/Abbotsford Police Commission meeting was called to order by President Todd Schmidt at 6:30 p.m. at the Colby/Abbotsford Police Department (CAPD). Members present were: Todd Schmidt, Dan Hederer, Randy Hesgard, Roger Weideman and Jeremy Totzke. Dennis Kramer participated by telephone. Also, present were: Police Chief Jason Bauer, Colby Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jessie Polivka, Lori Voss-City of Abbotsford Mayor, Alex Bowman-Officer, Kevin O'Brien-Tribune Phonograph and Jim Schmidt-City of Colby Mayor.

Public Comment: None.

Minutes from the September 10, 2018 meeting: Motion was made by Hederer, seconded by Hesgard to approve the minutes from the September 10, 2018 meeting as presented. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Expenditures: Motion was made by Hederer, seconded by Weideman to approve the expenditures as presented in the amount of \$22,544.92. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Lieutenant Position: Chief Bauer presented the committee with a job description for the lieutenant position. Chief Bauer took job descriptions he had received from other police departments in the area and complied them together for CAPD use. The position will be posted internally at the CAPD and will be a non-union position. Chief Bauer would like to see interviews for the position done at the November committee meeting, with approval of the chosen candidate at the December Abbotsford and Colby city council meetings. The chosen and approved candidate would start the position on January 1, 2019. There is currently \$1,200 in the 2019 CAPD budget to cover the wage increase the officer would receive for taking this position. Chief Bauer stated he will distribute a memo to the current officers and have anyone interested in interviewing for the position submit a letter of intent.

Motion was made by Weideman, seconded by Hederer to proceed with the lieutenant position with interviews being done at the November committee meeting and the chosen candidate being approved at the December council meetings with the approved candidate starting on January 1, 2019. Motion carried with a voice vote.

2019 Budget: Chief Bauer presented the committee with the most recent budget reflecting the changes that were discussed at the last meeting. The total budget amount is \$892,945. The committee discussed the areas of the budget that have increased. The salary line item is up significantly with the hiring of the School Resource Officer (SRO), but 75% of that amount will be reimbursed by the Abbotsford and Colby school districts. Bauer increased the training amount from 2018 because the wellness training that was approved needed to be re-scheduled until 2019. The money for the training will still be coming from the 2018 fund balance. The budget uses \$20,000 of the current fund balance to balance the 2019 budget.

Motion was made by Weideman, seconded by Hesgard to approve the 2019 budget as presented. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Chief's Report: Chief Bauer stated he had to order a body camera for SRO Officer Patrick Leichtnam. He also had to order one for Officer Bowman whose camera was damaged in an altercation with a suspect.

Bauer said he filled out restitution paperwork to recoup the cost of the camera. Bauer reported on the condition of the current vehicles and stated Officer Brandner's vehicle needs a significant amount of work. Bauer said both school superintendents are extremely pleased with Officer Leichtnam's work to date. President Schmidt suggested having Leichtnam attend the November meeting and give the committee an update on how things have been going. The K9 and arrest report was reviewed for August and September. The Click it or Ticket program administration is currently on hold. Bauer said he would contact the new Clark County Sheriff in January 2019 to seek the county's cooperation on participating in the program.

Motion was made by Hederer, seconded by Hesgard to accept and file the Chief's Report as presented. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Meeting date for November: The next meeting will be held on November 12, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Colby/Abbotsford Police Department.

Motion made by Totzke, seconded by Hedererto adjourn at 6:53 p.m. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Minutes from the City of Abbotsford Planning Committee meeting held FRIDAY NOVEMBER 9, 2018 in the Abbotsford City Hall Conference Room.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m.

Roll Call: Medenwaldt, Weideman, Jakel, Baker. Christensen - absent

Others Present: Administrator Grady, Public Works Director Stuttgen, Jim Colby, Jason Haas, Phil Haas, Kevin O'Brien – Tribune Phonograph.

Public Comments - Mr. Colby commented that he would like to see the homes in the Schilling subdivision zoned R1 or R2 and he would like to keep double wide homes out. He also wanted to know the proposed price of the lots.

Schilling Subdivision -

Chair Medenwaldt handed out a sheet of possible items to consider. Chair Medenwaldt stated that there were a couple of ways to look at the price of the lots. The city could use an incentive system or the city could just set a price. Chair Medenwaldt also brought up splitting lots. The city could opt to allow individuals to purchase 1-1/2 lots, however that could lead to excess space. The city could also require someone to buy the extra space if it came down to it.

Mr. Jakel stated he believed that the lots north of the apartments should be duplexes and the remaining lots should single family homes. Mr. Jakel also stated that the duplexes could be on concrete slabs, but the single family home should be required to have a basement. The committee agreed that duplexes would be allowed, but not 4 plexes.

Public Works Director Stuttgen stated that there should be a minimum building size requirement to purchase a subsidized lot and purchase 1-1/2 lots. Administrator Grady agreed that the city should consider its future tax base and require minimums.

The committee discussed start to finish times for construction. It was agreed that property owners should have a 1 year time period to build a house and an additional year to install a driveway that meets the city street.

There was some discussion about how selling subsidized lots would affect private owners trying to sell vacant lots in the Sportsman's additions. The committee agreed that issue at hand was the city getting the TIF increment and developing the property for the overall good of the city.

The committee discussed garages and accessory buildings. The committee agreed that any construction should follow current city ordinances that allow for a 3 car garage and an extra garage or accessory building.

Carports were briefly discussed and it was agreed that car ports should not be allowed.

Incentive pricing was discussed. Public Works Director Stuttgen stated that he believed that \$7,000 per lot would be a reasonable incentive price for prospective home owners. Ald. Weidemen expressed his concerns about providing the incentive price for spilt lots and how it will affect the city's tax base.

The committee briefly discussed whether factory built would be allowed or whether all homes had to be

stick built. There was no objection to factory built homes being allowed.

The committee agreed that an incentive price of 5,000/per lot shall only apply to the first lot. An addition lot would cost 14,000 and 12 a lot 7,000. The committee also agreed that a 1500 sq. ft. home should be valued at 1100 and that 112 sized lots should have a greater value.

Motion to approve all of the items discussed **Weideman/Jakl** – vote was unanimous.

Webb Property Update

Public Works Director Stuttgen informed the committee that the city was making a land swap with an adjoining parcel. The purpose was to square up the property and create a right of way. The city council has already been informed about the issue. In addition, the city council approved applying for a permit to install a railroad crossing at the property line.

- Holiday Program: Nov. 28th at 7:00 pm. Readings assigned. Board will be at the library at 6:00pm to help set up.
- Library afterschool discussion.

At the start of the month the library board issued two nine month bans and four three month bans to preteen/teens. The nine month bans were issued due to a verbal threat of violence. The three month bans were for behavior extremely inappropriate for a public library setting. All six youth had frequent behavior issues at the library before. In the past library staff would try correcting behavior or telling youth to leave for the day after three warnings. The director stated since the bans have been in place conditions in the library has greatly improved.

Kim Olson stated that some of the current youth using the library (banned youth included) are the worst behaved youth she has seen at the library in her 10 years of working here and that her eight-year-old daughter does not want to come with her to the library on Saturdays because, "those naughty kids will be there". The director stated that when the kids were a problem she saw people leave the library or choice not to come into the library. The director also stated that her biggest concern was use of drug in or around the library. One parent informed the director that her teen age daughter told her the one of the youths always at the library is a known drug dealer at the school (hearsay, not proven). Also, a small empty bag was found, when taken to the police department it was confirmed to be cocaine residue.

The board asked the director why the banned youth were using the library. The Director stated that some of the group used the public computers for gaming, if a program was being held they might join, but the most of the use was for a hang out spot and to use the wifi. Those with card rarely checked out materials and rarely was homework done. This would not be an issue, except that the behavior was not in line with the library's posted standards. The director informed the board that changes were made to the Standard of Conduct policy that would require more mature behavior from youth using the library without parent supervision. The board were still concerned that after the bans ended poor behavior would return to the library. The School Resource Officer mentioned the security risk of open wifi and mentioned that a business is not required to provide services after they are closed.

The board discussed changing library hours arrange it so two staff would close on late nights. The board determined that wifi seemed to the main cause of the library's behavior issues. The board decided to change wifi service.

Giffin moved that the Abbotsford Public Library's wifi be password protected, limited in range, and offered only during business hours (9:00 am to 7:45pm). Writz seconded. Motioned passed.

Writz moved that the library ask the city to lock the pubic room doors when not in use. Braun seconded. Motion passed.

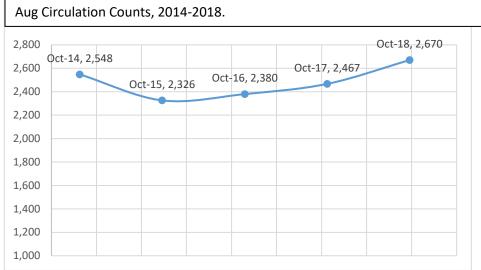

STANDARD OF CONDUCT FOR ABBOTSFORD PUBLIC LIBRARY PATRONS

All patrons are expected to respect the rights, property, health and safety of people who use or work at the Abbotsford Public Library in order to render its use most beneficial to the greatest number.

Examples of Inappropriate Behavior:

- 1. Noisy Behavior:
 - Loud talking, whistling, yelling
 - Disruptive use of cellular phones
 - Using radios, TVs, electronic devices, or other personal listening equipment at a level that disturbs others
 - Playing sound on public computers without headphones.
- 2. Behavior that disrupts or hinders public use of the library or that could be a health hazard:
 - Harassment or physical, sexual, or verbal abuse of library users or staff. May
 include initiating unwanted conversations, impeding access to the building, and
 swearing or profanity directed at others.
 - Excessive socializing and/ or excessive public displays of affection.
 - Failure to meet reasonable hygiene.
 - Failure to wear shirts or blouses or shoes. Swimsuits must be covered.
 - Rowdy behavior such as fighting on library property, running in the building, and throwing objects.
 - Excessive socializing and/or excessive public displays of affection.
 - Failure to meet a reasonable standard of personal hygiene.
 - Sleeping in the library or on library property.
 - Misuse of library furnishings, e.g., placing feet on furniture, or sitting on chair backs, counters, tables, or on the floor, unless permitted in a program or activity space.
 - Blocking aisles with backpacks and personal belongings, or storing them in locations other than chairs and counters.
 - Blocking sidewalks with bikes, skateboards, scooters, or other transportation device.
- 3. Abuse/vandalism of library facilities, materials or equipment, including attempting to access computer programs or computer system software that is restricted to staff use.
- 4. Failure to follow library rules and regulations:

Rules and Regulations:

- Any unlawful behavior is prohibited on library property; such as theft, gambling, exhibitionism/ flashing, loitering (including refusal to leave library promptly at closing), possession, sale or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances.
- Use of tobacco is prohibited on library property.
- Food and beverages do a pose a potential risk to collections, equipment and furnishings, and are not allowed in the library unless provided as part of a library program.
- Disturbing literature, taking surveys, asking patrons or employees to sign petitions, or similar activities are not allowed.

- Soliciting is prohibited in the library or on library grounds, except as allowed on Meeting Room policies.
- Bringing animals into the library is prohibited, except those used as aids to people with disabilities or they are part of a library- sponsored program. Animals may not be left unattended on library property.
- ID must be shown to a library staff member upon request.
- Possessions should be submitted to a library staff member for inspection upon request if illegal or unlawful activity is suspected.

Parents or other legal guardians are responsible for the behavior of their minor children in the library.

Procedures to be used by staff in enforcing this standard:

Library staff will intervene in situations that present a danger to the safety of people or property, interfere with the rights of others, constitute disturbing or inappropriate use of the library, and/or involve the commission of illegal acts.

- 1. Request that the patron(s) immediately discontinue any inappropriate behavior.
- 2. If the disruptive behavior does not improve, speak to the patron again. Request that the patron identify themselves. If the patron does not identify themselves it is the library's right to ask them to leave. If they do not leave, call the police. If the patron identifies themselves record the date, the person(s)'s name and behavior in a log book located at the circulation desk.
- 3. If the disruptive behavior still does not improve after you have spoken to the patron(s) a second time, contact a supervisor.
- 4. If a supervisor is not available and you must speak to the patron(s) a third time, explain that he/she must leave the premises for the day or you will call the police. Record in log book.
- 5. Call the police if necessary.
- 6. Adult individuals who are recorded in the library's behavior log book three times in one school year will be banned from the library for a period of determined by the director. Individuals under eighteen who are recorded in the library behavior log book three times in one school year will require a meeting with the youth's parents/guardian before they can return for the library within the school year. Failure to meet with parents will result in a ban until the next school year. At the meeting with the parents the director will inform the parents/guardian of the behavior that the library is finding disruptive. The youth will be giving one more chance to display appropriate library behavior, however if they fail to meet this standard they can only use the library if accompanied by their parent/guardian until the next school year.

Extreme inappropriate conduct as determined by the library director or library board will result immediate bans. Ex. Harassment or physical, sexual, or verbal abuse or threat of library users or staff. Unlawful behavior such as theft, gambling, exhibitionism/ flashing, possession, sale or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances.

Banning and Appeal:

When an individual's inappropriate conduct is serious or repeated, the library Director may, at his or her discretion, restrict that individual's access to the library and/or suspend or revoke library services to the person. Individuals who violate federal laws or local ordinances may be prosecuted.

• Banning Procedure:

After staff determine that a person has engaged in severe or repeat misconduct and staff has determined that the individual involved should be banned:

- 1. Staff will verbally inform the individual that they have been banned and if possible issue a written ban letter to the individual involved notifying the individual that they are banned from the Abbotsford Public Library. The letter shall indicate the reasons for the ban and the time period of the ban. If individuals are under eighteen the director may request a meeting with the youth's parents/guardian.
- 2. The Director and Library Board of Trustees will review and may reconsider the decision to ban an individual upon written request of the individual and may shorten or terminate the banning period if information submitted by the individual warrants such modification.

• Non-compliance with Ban - Trespassing:

If a banned individual enters the Abbotsford Public Library before the return date listed in the ban letter, police will be called.

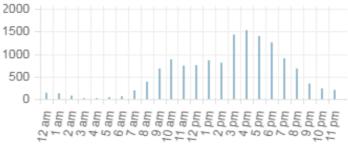

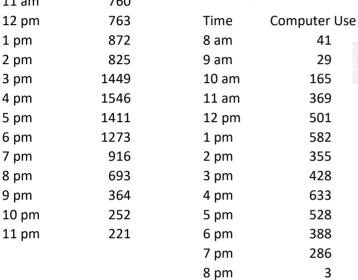

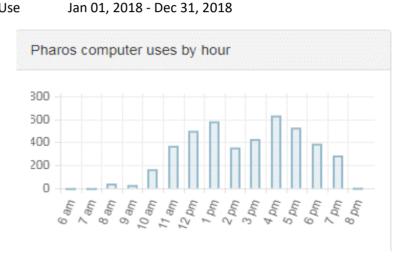
